2nd Annual Dolph Briscoe Memorial BBQ Cook-off Presented by Oasis Outback Chef's Choice (Open) - Friday, May 25, 2012

Rules & Regulations

- 1. Contestants may begin checking in Friday, May 25, 2012 at 7am.
- 2. Teams may consist of one or more members. Each team must cook on their own pit. One (1) team One (1) pit.
- 3. BBQ PITS -

Pit – any commercial or homemade, trailered or untrailered, pit or smoker normally used for competitive BBQ. Fires shall be of wood, wood pellets or charcoal. A BBQ pit may include gas or electricity for starting the combustion of wood or wood products, but NOT to complete cooking.

Backyard Cooker – Any cooking device by design or nature that is inherently portable and by design is intended for recreational cooking.

Open Fires – When open fire and ground pits are used, it is in the interest of safety, that a barrier be placed around said open fire pit. A fire extinguisher shall be readily available. NO fires shall be built on top of the ground.

Accessories – The use of electric spits, augers or forced draft fans is permitted.

- 4. No pre-seasoning or pre-cooking of meat is allowed until it has been inspected and approved. Once the meat has been inspected and approved it must not leave the cook-off site.
- 5. Chief Cook will be responsible for the conduct of his/her team & guests. The excessive use of alcoholic beverages shall be grounds for disqualification. **Under no circumstances are alcoholic beverages to be sold to the General Public, or given to a MINOR.**
- 6. It is the responsibility of the team to see that the contest area is kept clean, and the area is clean following the contest. There will be a dumpster provided to dispose of the trash. If your area is left unclean, you will not be invited back.
- 7. **QUIET TIME BEGINS AT 12 MIDNIGHT**. Please respect your neighbors. This is not a battle of the speakers. If you have large lamps or speakers keep them turned in toward your spot.
- 8. Spaces will be 40x30 and 40x20. Pop-ups, Trailers, and Motor homes are allowed. Vehicles and other equipment may not exceed the boundary of the contestant's assigned space.
- 9. There will be ice for sale on premises.
- 10. Mandatory Cook's Meeting is at 6pm, Friday, May 25. Containers will be given out at this time.
- 11. Turn-in time for Chef's Choice (Open) is 8pm. Judging and awards will immediately follow.
- 12. First and second place trophies will be awarded.
